Humane Society of Seneca County Rules for Animal Care and Handling

- 1. The main focus of the Humane Society is the care and well-being of the animals in our care. If you are found abusing, neglecting, or being in any way cruel to the animals, you will be asked to leave.
- 2. When socializing cat, there is to be <u>ONLY ONE</u> cat out in a room at a time. The only exception is cats that are housed together.
- 3. When placing animals back in their kennels, be sure they are in the same kennel they came out of, and the kennel is latched. <u>Always check and re-check</u>.
- 4. Unless you are in the fenced in back yard, dogs should ALWAYS be on a leash.
- 5. When getting a dog out of its kennel, you must always have control over the animal, if you are uncomfortable handling a dog, move on to another one, or find a staff member to assist you.
- 6. While walking dogs, they much be kept separate, unless otherwise stated by a staff member.
- 7. If a dog does get away from you, <u>DO NOT CHASE IT.</u> Immediately find and notify a staff member.
- 8. If you are uncomfortable handling any animal, <u>DO NOT TRY TO HANDLE IT</u>. Move on to another animal, or find a staff member.
- 9. If you are unsure of how to do something or have any questions, please ask a staff member.
- 10. Our main goal is to keep <u>EVERYONE</u>, humans and animals, happy, safe and healthy. Please be thoughtful while working with animals. Your time is a great asset in helping them find loving homes.

Humane Society of Seneca County Rules of Conduct for Volunteers

- 1. While you are volunteering at the Humane Society, you are representing us, proper attire is required. This includes:
 - Pants/shorts that protect the legs. NO "SHORT SHORTS".
 - Appropriate shoes. NO SANDALS, FLIP-FLOPS, OR OPEN TOED SHOES.
 - Shirts must have sleeves and should not have any obscene wording, pictures, etc.
- 2. Follow directions, we have protocols and policies for a reason.
- 3. Mistreatment of the animals in any way will result in you being asked to leave. There are cameras located throughout the building/property; mistreatment will not be tolerated.
- 4. You are expected to be courteous and polite to EVERYONE: staff members, other volunteers, the public, etc. Any inappropriate behavior towards anyone will not be tolerated.
- 5. Illegal drugs, activities, the use of alcohol, etc. are prohibited on HSSC property. Any suspected use will not be tolerated.
- 6. Please do not enter any "Employee Only" areas unless instructed to do so by a staff member.
- 7. If you are not sure how to do something or are not sure where something is, <u>PLEASE</u> ASK.
- 8. The animals and their health and safety are the most important thing while you are here. If you notice an animal not acting right, or appears sick in any way, please let a staff member know.
